S. No	Points Of Discussion
	The meeting was formally started with the recitation of Holy Quran. President RCCI Mr. Javed Akhtar Bhatti welcomed all the participants.
01.	Chairman Mr. Abdul Majeed Amjad elaborated the agenda of the meeting.
02.	He proposed to establish hospital in the surrounding area of the Rawalpindi. He also announced to construct a block in his personal capacity within the hospital. This project will be inaugurated by Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan.
03.	He also offered 2 Kanals of land to RCCI for the construction of hospital (if approved by RCCI managing committee on less than market rate) in which 5 story building is available that is at the round side opposite shaheen cargo complex Islamabad airport.
04.	He introduced Mr. Shah Nawaz (architect specialized in Hospital designing) who will develop layout for the hospital and provide true consultancy till completion.
05.	He said that in order to initiate this project; correspondence with the corporate sector will be started.
06.	He added that negotiation with Print media may be started to dedicate one page to CSR once in a week. He said that Jang newspaper and Nawa-e-waqt has already accepted this request.
07.	Moreover, he said that in order to promote cultural activities, entertainments programs will be arranged.
08.	He further said that there is a need to widen airport corner road, RDA should be taken on board to settle down this problem.
09.	He said that government may acknowledge social workers by presenting them appropriate awards.
10.	Mr. Abdul Ghafoor Khan member RCCI proposed to make a feasibility of the hospital, which may be presented to the corporate sector for investment. He announced to invest on one room in hospital.
11.	He added that the scholarships may be provided to the students to continue their studies.
12.	Ch, Pervaiz Ahmed (executive member) appreciated Mr. Abdul Majeed enthusiasm and assured maximum support on behalf of the chamber.
13.	President RCCI Mr. Javed Akhtar Bhatti praised the house and said that there is a need to tap corporate sector and create awareness regarding CSR.
