S. No.	Points Of Discussion
	The meeting was formally started with the recitation of Holy Quran.
1.	The Chairman Standing Committee Mr. Fazal Khaliq Lungrial inaugurated the meeting & thanked all the participants.
2.	Chairman discussed that they have prepared an agenda in which all the issues are mentioned.
3.	Chairman discussed the electricity bills issue that in Rawalpindi region industrial area is mixed with the residential area that's why electric meters are not separate. So it suggested that commercial meters should be separate from the residential meters.
4.	Chairman also highlighted the transformer issue that when it creates some problem then wapda takes a lot of time. By this they face a loss of time, money and so it was suggested by them that it should be privately handled. By this, their time and wastage of money will be safe.
5.	A cantonment related issues were also discussed in which property tax was the focus point by all the members. Presidents Manzar Khurshid Sheikh Suggest that they should file their cases in the court and RCCI will support and guide them in every way but will not directly involve in the legal matters.
6.	Chairman also discussed the transportation problem in the meeting as they don't have the proper place for the vehicles because due to security issues police department not allow them to place their vehicles in the day time specially and they are only allowed to exit only in nights. By this they are facing a problem. The second issue they discussed that waste material of industrial are not allowed to move in/out of the area. So it was suggested that some measures should be taken to handle this situation.
7.	Chairman also discussed the issues of regarding blasting of marble blocks.
9.	Senior Vice President of RCCI discussed and acknowledged all the issues and problems and said that RCCI will support them and will discussed all the issues with the higher authorities and will try to solve it as soon as possible.
10.	Chairman also discussed that area should be allocated for the industrial zone of marble.
11.	President said that Committee should write a letter to cantonment board, DCO's and IESCO about their issues.
12.	President Mr. Manzar khurshid sheikh also said that they will get support from the platform of RCCI in solving their issues.
